


Installation Guide Replacing Deck Hatch Gasket



For Low Profile Deck Hatch (LDH)

For Regular Deck Hatch (DH)

- 1. Using a screw driver or retractable blade, make a small "starter cut" into the old gasket.
- 2. We recommend ripping as much of the old gasket out as possible. Avoid cutting, because when cut along the sides, it leaves more small pieces vs. pulling the gasket out.
- 3. Use alcohol/mild solvent to clean out remaining gasket and sealant from rim.
- 4. Measure gasket length needed, place gasket around rim for measurement, cut to length.
- 5. Deck hatch corners: Mark where fanned cuts are to be made in gasket for the rounded corners.
- 6. Bond end pieces of gasket with super glue and let dry completely before placing in the rim.
- 7. Make sure that the rim is completely dry and cleaned out before adding a small bead of sealant/silicone. Less is more, you can always add more.
- 8. Inspect rim making sure silicone is evenly distributed, apply more silicone if needed.
- 9. Close lid to make sure that gasket is seated in the rim, inspect gasket and make sure there are no gaps or buckling when closed or open.
- 10. Final step is to add any additional silicone sealant, if needed. Close deck hatch lid and let dry for 2-3 days in well-ventilated area.
